


# PLEASE SHARE WITH ALL MEMBERS OF YOUR ORGANIZATION PRIOR TO PARADE DAY

## LINE UP AREA



**Yellow=All units EXCEPT Walking Units and Bands**

**Blue= Buses Dropping off Bands or school units**

**Pink= Lineup Area Lanes**

**Red= Walking Unit Drop off**

All units must be assembled and check-in between 6:45am-8:15am at the one of the three check in points.

Check-in for floats and all moving vehicle units: Will be at the lineup area. ONLY Floats and vehicles in the parade lineup will be allowed entrance via Compton Dr. off of Monticello Ave. the morning of the parade. Units that have walkers with their float will have to have the float enter via Compton Dr. and the walkers will need to be dropped off on the opposite side of Kaplan Arena; their drivers/parents will ONLY BE ALLOWED TO ENTER via Ukrop Way off of Jamestown Rd. YOU WILL BE TURNED AWAY AT COMPTON which will prolong your entrance to the event so plan ahead and arrive early.

Check-in point for buses: If your group is arriving by a bus that will be dropping off participants and not riding in the parade but needs to wait for the participants at the end of the event, please plan to have those busses enter via Ukrop Way off of Jamestown road and you will be directed to the lineup area where you can unload participants and then proceed to the dispersal area via Richmond Rd. THIS MUST BE BEFORE 8am AS THE ROADS WILL BE CLOSING BEGINNING AT 8:30am AND THE BUS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PROCEED TO THE DISPERSAL AREA UNTIL AFTER THE ENTIRE PARADE IS FINISHED. Please share with your drivers.

Check-in point for Walking Units: Walking groups *without* a rolling float (scouts, dancers, dogs, gymnasts, etc.) will need to enter the lineup area via Ukrop Way off of Jamestown road ONLY. Units that have walkers that need to be dropped off will need to be dropped off on the opposite side of Kaplan Arena; their drivers/parents will ONLY BE ALLOWED TO ENTER via Ukrop Way off of Jamestown Rd. YOU WILL BE TURNED AWAY AT COMPTON which will prolong your entrance to the event so plan ahead and arrive early. Please share this information with parents and other individuals in your organization. Your group may of course gather elsewhere in the area (i.e. one of the churches, a friend's home, School of Ed., etc.) and walk to the lineup area as a group if you so choose. One person should check-in with the check-in desk at Kaplan Arena once you are in the lineup area.

There will be no parking in that area and no cars will be let through to the staging area. Each group is responsible for having someone there to collect their additional walkers if your group has parents utilizing the drop-off area.


If your Parade Unit includes both a float and walkers: The float must check in at the float and moving vehicle check-in and the walkers must be dropped off at the walking unit area and move to their place in the lineup to meet the rest of their group.

All units must have someone from your unit check in at the registration table and a parade volunteer will give you your number once you are in line.

Check- in ends promptly at 8:15am, therefore no units will be able to check-in after 8:15. All streets close at 8:30am, so all units must be in place by 8:30am. The parade begins promptly at 9am (with or without you)!!!!

All entry points to and around the parade staging area are monitored by Police Officers and Security. Without proper credentials, they will not clear you to enter.

# Dispersal Area



**Yellow = Moving units that do not need to break down – Proceed down Francis St.**

**Red = Walking units that need to wait for parent pick up on the lawn of DeWitt Wallace Museum**

**Blue = Bands and Floats that need to dismantle in W&M Facilities Lot**

PARADE ROUTE ENDS AT THE CORNER OF FRANCIS AND HENRY ST.! You are not finished with the parade route until you have reached the dispersal area and Parade Marshalls have directed you to the dismantling area for your unit. Continue marching to the assigned dismantling area.

Walking group parents should plan to pick up children at the dispersal area of the DeWitt-Wallace Museum Lawn (Summer Breeze Concert Area). Floats with walkers may stay together and parents can walk to the W&M Law School overflow parking lot to pick up children.

**DO NOT DRIVE TO PICK UP YOUR CHILD. YOU MUST WALK TO PICK UP YOUR CHILD. NO CARS OTHER THAN PARADE UNITS WILL BE ALLOWED THROUGH.**

There is no participant parking at Dispersal. Use other nearby parking lots. Plan ahead!!!

Buses will be parked in the designated area of the W&M Law School overflow parking lot waiting to pick up participants who arrived by bus.

Vehicle units that do not need to dismantle can continue down Francis Street and leave the area.

If your unit needs to be dismantled before proceeding through town, you must dismantle immediately and move your unit out of the dispersal area. Units must be supervised and have the ability to be moved at all times while in the dispersal area. Abandoned units will risk disqualification for 2020.

The Parade Marshal and/or police directions supersede these instructions, follow their directions.
